Restoring PV's 1-room school



The effort to restore and preserve the Forest Grove Schoolhouse, one of the earliest structures in the Pleasant Valley school district, was related at the Nov. 28 meeting by **Barbara**Andersen, whose

family has owned and farmed the land



around the school for generations. She and her brothers form the core of that restoration effort.

Beginning in the 1870s, Pleasant Valley had five one-room schools – located so students had to walk no more than two miles to reach them. With more than 12,000 such schools at the time, Iowa had more than any other state. In the early 20th century, communities began to consolidate schools, and the Forest Grove School is one of the comparative few remaining. The goal of the restoration effort, Barbara said, is "to show what it was like in a one-room school."



With the help of many volunteers and fundraising events, the restoration work has already begun – the building was raised and a new foundation has been poured. One unexpected benefit of the

efforts, she said, was "all of the stories of the school" as told by its alumni.

When finished, the restored building will look as it did in the 1940s, near the end of its life as a school, she said. Besides being an opportunity for today's children to visit and learn about education in a one-room schoolhouse, Barbara said it will be available for community events, such as group meetings and weddings.

The restoration will cost about \$250,000, and about 10% of that has been raised so far, she said. For more information, visit the group's Website:
