**Interim superintendent of  
BCSD is next speaker**

The scheduled speaker at the Aug. 24 meeting is **Michael Raso**, interim superintendent of the Bettendorf



Community School District. Mike will serve in that capacity during the 2016-2017 school year. He has been the district's assistant superintendent since fall 2008.

He replaces Theron Schutte who resigned after becoming superintendent of the Marshalltown, Iowa, Community School District

on July 1. The Bettendorf Board of Education intends to start the search in November to fill the permanent superintendent's position by July 2017.

Mike has earned a superintendent's license plus an Ed. S. (Specialist in Education) and Masters in Secondary Education Administration from Drake University. He received a B.A. in Elementary Education with additional certifications from the University of Northern Iowa.

**Friendly House -  
help since 1896**

**Terry Hendershott**, assistant director of the Friendly House, Davenport, presented "Friendly House by the numbers" during the Aug. 17 meeting – amounting to a series of snapshots of the way the organization has been meeting community needs since its founding in 1896. His "count-up" of numbers revealed:

- ➔**62:** the number of seniors regularly served last year. One of them, who celebrated her 100<sup>th</sup> birthday, began her association with Friendly House, Terry said, when she was 5 years old. "We have many programs for seniors," he said.
- ➔**120:** the number of years Friendly House has been serving the community
- ➔**152:** the number of "rebates" of \$1,000 given last year to help people with low incomes pay their rent

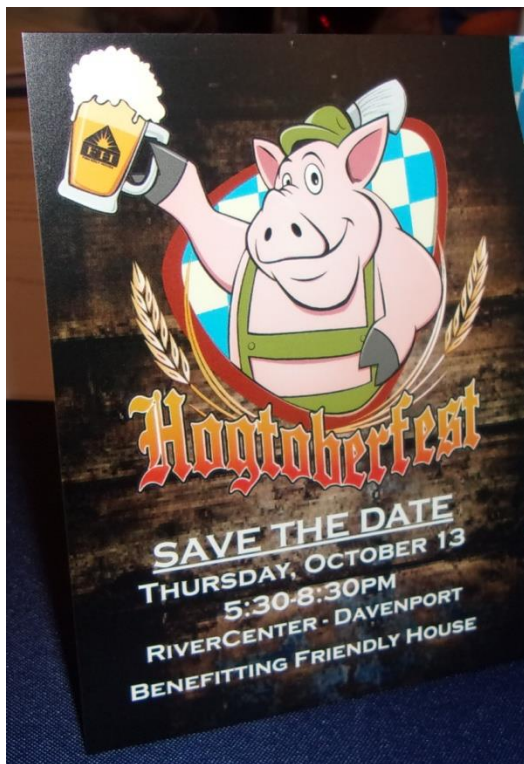
→**192**: the number of children enrolled in programs last year – including all-day daycare, partial-day day-care, pre-school, kindergarten-preparatory, after-school care and summer programs

→**213**: the number of requests for services that Friendly House does not provide – which resulted in referrals to agencies that do provide them, often by FH’s in-house social worker

→**217**: the number of Friendly House volunteers last year

→**267**: the number of families that received holiday food baskets last year

→**372**: the number of families that came to the FH food pantry at least once last year. “A family can get food from us



once a month,” Terry said. Most often they’re working-poor, who have suffered some financial setback, which reduced the money available for food, he explained.

→**972**: The number of free tax returns, prepared last year by volunteers – “which

returned about a million dollars in refunds to the community,” he said

→**3,400**: the number of volunteer hours contributed to Friendly House last year

→**6,900**: the number of passengers – mostly kids and seniors – carried to FH programs, ranging from cultural enrichment to recreation to special events

→**9,100**: the number of people, beyond regular clients, who used FH facilities, especially its Community Room and gym – for meetings, sports, parties, church services, weddings and funerals...

→**9,600**: the number of individuals who got food from the FH pantry last year

→**63,000**: pounds of food purchased last year from the Riverbend Food Pantry

Friendly House’s next fundraising event is “Hogtoberfest,” billed as “a night of pork, beer and specialty-drink samples,” 5:30-8:30 p.m., Thursday, Oct. 13, at the RiverCenter, Davenport. Advance tickers are \$40; \$50 at the door.
